Reminders for Spectators

- Students from Harding and the visiting school(s) are welcome **with student ID. Student ID or equivalent is required for admission.**
- K-8 students and 9-12 students from non-participating high schools must be accompanied by an *adult* chaperone. ***Adult chaperones must be at least 25 years old.***
- Backpacks and bags are not allowed.
- No outside food or drink. Concessions available for sale - **CASH ONLY**
- No Re-entry: Fans will not be allowed re-entry once they have exited the building/venue.
- No admittance after half-time of the varsity game.
- Home/Visitor Seating - fans are expected to sit in their designated seating section.

Additional St. Paul Public School District Policies:

- Students from the hosting school and visiting school(s) are welcome with student ID. No student ID, no entry.
- Students from any other schools/non-participating schools must be accompanied by an adult chaperone.
- Middle school students and younger must be accompanied by an adult chaperone.
- Re-entry Policy: Fans will not be allowed re-entry once they have exited the building/venue.
 - Exception will only apply in which restrooms or concessions are not within the venue.
- Home/Visitor seating: Fans are expected to be in their designated school's section.
- Backpacks are not allowed.
- No outside food or drink is allowed if concessions are sold on site.
- SPPS Prohibits the following at School Events
 - Weapons, Alcoholic Beverages, E Cigarettes / Vaping, Tobacco, & Controlled Substances
- **Those suspected of being under the influence will not be admitted and are subject to removal.
- Spectators are prohibited from bringing balls into an event.
- Only hand-held signs are allowed. Signs must be positive, appropriate, promote the participants and not be distracting or block the view of others.
- Artificial noise makers are prohibited.
- Only authorized personnel will be admitted onto the playing surface.
- Animals, other than service animals, are not permitted in the event.

Persons who violate these rules may be ejected without refund.
